Mega Millions has always given Marylanders a chance at a life-changing jackpot. Now those jackpots are about to get even bigger. Beginning with the drawing on April 8, 2025, the new starting jackpot will increase to **\$50 million**, and the average jackpot win is projected to **increase 75%**!

And there's more big news! Second-tier Match 5 prizes with a new built-in multiplier will range from **\$2 million up to \$10 million**. The prize for matching the Mega Ball alone will increase up to \$10-\$50, depending on the multiplier players receive.

Drawings will still take place every **Tuesday and Friday** night.

THE PRICE IS GOING UP, BUT SO IS THE VALUE!

Your customers may ask why the **price of the game is increasing from \$2 (\$3 with the megaplier) to \$5**. Here's why:

- Jackpots will grow faster
- Prize amounts at all levels below the jackpot will be higher
- Minimum win of \$10 on every winning ticket
- Minimum prize is 2X the cost of the ticket
- Each play comes with a built-in multiplier
- With only 24 numbers to choose from in the Mega Ball field, the odds of winning the jackpot and the overall probability of winning a prize improve
- Average jackpots will be bigger

Players who prefer a \$2 base cost for a multi-state jackpot game have the option of playing Powerball.

NEW BUILT-IN MEGAPLIER!



Players will automatically get a multiplier that increases non-jackpot prize amounts when they win. The multiplier is randomly generated by the terminal for each line of numbers that a player purchases. Each line is played separately.


The old megaplier is going away because a new built-in multiplier is now included in the price of every single wager. Players' non-jackpot wins will be multiplied from 2x to 10x on every play.

The individual multiplier values (2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, or 10x) will be randomly assigned per play at the time of purchase. That means a possible minimum win of \$10 and up to \$10 million on non-jackpot prizes.

NEW PLAYSLIPS!

Newly designed playslips will be delivered in specially marked boxes to retailers by UPS between 3/28/25 and 4/2/25. You can begin using these new playslips on 4/5/25. Old playslips may be discarded after that date.

ADVANCE SALE STEP-DOWN

In anticipation of planned enhancements to Mega Millions coming on 4/5/2025, the number of advance draws will be reduced beginning on 2/15/25, after the Mega Millions drawing on 2/14/25. Advance play for the NEW Mega Millions will begin on 4/5/2025, with the first drawing on 4/8/2025.

ADDITIONAL SELLING INFORMATION

If a player buys more than one line of numbers, the player will receive a multiplier on each line of play since a multiplier is generated separately for each \$5 line of numbers purchased. Each line is played separately. Each multiplier applies only to the line on which it appears.

If a player buys a ticket that covers multiple drawing dates (advance drawings) the player's multipliers will be the same for each drawing. Each play (each line of numbers) that a player purchases will have a multiplier that will apply to all drawing dates covered by the ticket.

If a player buys a ticket for multiple drawing dates and cashes it in for winnings before the last drawing date on their ticket, the "Exchange" ticket received for the remaining drawings will have the same multipliers as the original ticket.

A "Replay" ticket may not have the same multipliers as the original ticket. Multipliers are always generated separately for each line on each new ticket. A "Replay" ticket is considered a new ticket, so using the "Replay" function does not guarantee that a player will receive the same multipliers as on their original ticket.
